

How to Use [Medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) to research and enroll in your Medicare Rx Plan (applies to Medicare Supplement Enrollees only)

1. Go to www.medicare.gov
2. At the top right of the screen, click on **Health and Drug Plans**
3. Next, click on **Find health & drug plans**
4. Enter your Zip Code and click **Continue**
5. Select **Medicare drug plan (Part D)** then **Find Plans**
6. If you don't get any help paying for your drug plan from the programs listed, indicate that on the next screen and click **Continue**
7. Next you want to indicate that you DO want to see the drug costs when you compare plans and then click **Next**
8. This next step is where you add the exact names of all your meds, the dosage and frequency
9. Once you've entered all of your medications, click **Done Adding Drugs**
10. In the next step you can choose up to five pharmacies that are convenient to you. I always suggest including mail order as well.
11. At the bottom of the screen select **Done**
12. At this point you can review the plan options and if there is a more competitive plan than the one you are currently on, you can enroll in that plan by clicking on **Enroll** or by calling the non-member 800# listed on **Plan Details**

This is the **quickest and easiest** way to keep your Medicare Rx plan current and up to date.
